





Why is a strong roof membrane so important?

- 1. Weight load of the layers above: Rain water is soaked up in soil instead of draining off the roof.
- 2. Membrane Punctures:
 - Roots grow and can get through filter and drainage layers putting the membrane at risk of punctures.
 - Pests and insects are attracted to the vegetation and may cause damage to the entire system.
- 3. Protects the support / structure layers below to keep repair costs down.

Benefits of a Green Roof: Conserves energy, increases building value, extends the life of the roof by protecting the membrane, helps the environment by reducing carbon.
